During the 'school run' cars park half on the road half on the pavement. This results in a much reduced thoroughfare to the extent that ambulances and fire tenders have great difficulty in passing, in some cases it is even too narrow to pass

Council Response

Thank you for submitting a petition on behalf of the residents of Folkestone Court requesting double yellow lines to be introduced to help reduce dangerous parking around school drop off and pick up times.

We have added this request to our Waiting Restriction Request list. On review of this list later in the year, we will propose double yellow lines along the North side of the road, which will leave one side clear for parking and still leave adequate space for emergency vehicles. However if you would like to make any amendments to this plan, we would be happy to consider these.

Before implementing any new or amended restrictions, we must follow our statutory consultation process to advertise the proposal and invite comments from anyone who may be affected by the proposal. Providing there are no objections to the proposals, the new waiting restrictions can be introduced. The process from designing the scheme to completion can take up to 6 months.
