

# Paper Petition Details

## Mundesley Spur & Mildenhall Road Parking

It has always been difficult for the residents of Mundesley Spur to enter and exit our road safely on Friday afternoons and several complaints have been made, directly or via our Neighbourhood meetings, some have been attended by police officers where our concerns have been raised. It has now become extremely dangerous for the residents to exit our road as we have absolutely no chance of seeing if any traffic is coming along Mildenhall Road and a resident's car has been hit because of this.

We have been repeatedly told that it is only for an hour during Mosque day, this is not the case, parking starts from 12 noon on both sides of our road, on the pavements, on both comers and along both sides of Mildenhall Road.

Friday 6th April, being a Bank Holiday restricted which residents could come and go from their own street solely on what the width of the car they drove. Inconsiderate parking as usual left no room for some cars to enter Mundesley Spur where they live. Photographs can be supplied.

We have been putting up with this dangerous situation long enough and have tried to understand the extra parking needed on a particular day, It Is not just one day or one hour. If the residents are unable to enter their own street then how can emergency services enter if needed?

We would like to suggest a solution to our problem and would urge you to consider our request on the grounds of safety and for residents to come and go when they so wish from their own street without danger to themselves or others. At present the elderly and parents with young children and pushchairs are forced to walk In the middle of the road.

We would like to request the provision of double yellow lines on one comer and possibly down one side of our street to the alley, preventing parking. This would leave enough room for us to come and go, residents to walk on the pavement. This will allow residents ease of access and ensure vision of traffic and eliminate the danger. It will also allow any necessary emergency vehicles to get through.
