Council Response

The land at Sheehy Way is not a public car park given that the Housing Department, who own the site, do not operate and manage it as such.

This Housing site would not be for the exclusive use of the Temple/clubs on Sheehy Way without some formal agreement or permission and that the site was originally intended for the use of local housing residents. These are not in place.

The Temple use this land due to general lack of management of the site as a car park. This land has been proposed as part of the phased development of much needed new council homes in the borough as it is on housing owned land.

A planning application has been recently submitted by SUR in partnership with the council itself, and as such this petition should be submitted to the planning committee and relevant planners for consideration.
