

Paper Petition Details

Removal of Yellow Lines - Thirkleby Close

Slough Council Parking Department receive the petition below - to remove newly installed double yellow lines on left and right bends of the hammer head at Thirkleby Close, SL1 3XF.

Built in the 1960s Thirkleby Close estate is a private self managed community situated in a Cul-de-sac which has always benefited from street parking. On Thursday 11th October, 2018 the above yellow lines were installed by Slough Council. The reason given for this was, back in 2017 early morning refuse collections were often obstructed by parked cars. However since then collection time has been moved forward and we believe this has now resolved the issue.

Therefore the current benefits from a 24 hour 7 day week parking restrictions are far outweighed by the loss of 44 meters of available overnight parking for residents.

We also take this opportunity to again request the installation of speed humps to our street for added protection to small children who play out on the estate.

Since receiving this petition we have conducted several site visits which have shown the new double yellow lines to be necessary to assist with visibility and the flow of traffic at this location. However we have taken your comments on board and have therefore made the decision to continue monitoring this location for the next 2 months and as lead petitioner, we will write to you with the final outcome after this period has elapsed. During this time we will also be liaising with Ameys to ascertain if they are still having any issues during refuse collections.
