Parking Issues at Grace Court

We are writing this petition as non-residents are parking on the alleyway which is entrance to 12 communal flats. The alleyway entrance is very narrow and considering non-residents are parking on the both sides of the alleyway what makes it very difficult for residence car to come and go inside the property. Considering there are no restrictions on the alleyway they park on both the sides, left side of alleyway is pavement and they park on pavements leaving no space for families with kids to walk with prams which is health and safety issue. When we requested non-residents to stop parking they get aggressive and said they have rights to park and scare the residents that they can break glasses, scratch car etc, there are about 10-12 cars parked on both sides every day. They also throw food waste and rubbish on the alleyway after eating takeaways in car. The cars standing here have a lanyard on them and I believe they work for Arvato.

Once the car is parked on both the sides of alleyway vans, ambulance, bin collection vans, shopping vans can't come inside due to cars been parked on both the sides. Waste bins are not being collected as they can't get inside the premises and result of this we have waste bins getting flooded, We have foxes in the night and also we have seen rats which is health and safety issue. Last time we had one of the resident who was not feeling well and ambulance couldn't come inside the premises because of cars being parked on both sides. I am sure in case of fire even fire brigade can't enter.

We have emailed few times to Slough Borough Council and also met in person about this issues but didn't have much luck. We have also reported the same to police as well. When we reported to Slough Parking Enforcement team they said nothing can be done as there are no restrictions. We also got response via email that we can request the restrictions to be added and this will be reviewed by 2020. We would like to request for some actions to be taken on priority basis i.e. have restrictions/yellow lines to be in place. We had also submitted pictures to evidence the above.
