

EXTRAORDINARY COUNCIL MEETING - MOTION ON KASHMIR

“The Council agrees to support the local campaigns in raising awareness of the crisis in Kashmir, especially as Slough is host to a large Kashmiri community who are concerned about their families who are struggling in Kashmir and desire the support of Council in their effort to campaign for short and long term resolution.

The Council resolves to write to:

1. India High Commissioner urging India to immediately restore articles 370 and 35A and lift the oppressive controls of the civilian population.
2. The Secretary General of the United Nations, asking that they use their influence to secure their urgent amelioration of the situation.
3. The UK Foreign Secretary, to ask that Britain uses its full influence as a permanent member of the UN Security Council to assist in the above.”
