## **Council Response**

Thank you for your petition requesting waiting restrictions on Whitehaven, to help improve the problems with access currently experienced by residents and refuse collectors.

We are proposing Double Yellow lines at the junction with Montague Road, and along Whitehaven in its entirety; these indicate 'no waiting at any time'. This restriction will also apply to the residents of Whitehaven. However if you feel this is not acceptable, or have any other suggestions, we would be happy to discuss these with you and consider alternative solutions.

Once we have agreed an acceptable scheme, this will be added to our waiting restriction request list which is due to be reviewed at the beginning of next year. We will then put the proposal out to a formal consultation, and providing there are no objections, the lines can be implemented.
