### Council Response

Thank you for your petition regarding changing the time of operation of the residents parking zone on The Crescent.

The operating times of the residents parking zone on The Crescent was originally changed due to a number of complaints and a petition from residents requesting the restrictions are enforceable 24 hours a day. This is due to non residents and multi occupancy households being able to park without restriction overnight, reducing the number of available spaces as demand for parking in this area is high.

There are options for visitors to park in the evenings and on weekends as visitors vouchers are available from the parking shop. These can be used to allow your visitors to park within the zone without being issued with a Penalty Charge Notice. If we were to reduce the hours of enforcement, we feel that this would be detrimental to parking in the area as the number of spaces available will almost certainly be reduced through commuters and multi occupancy households using the spaces.

For these reasons, we will not be changing the times of the residents parking zone at this time.
