Parking Issues on Peel Court

We the undersigned would like to highlight the following problems around Parking on Peel Court.

- Access / parking issues for Transport Ambulance in Peel Court with cars parking opposite house and reluctant to move
- Some issues with uncooperative neighbour (No. 4 Peel Court they have many issues with most Peel Court residents i.e. anti social behaviour / no respect for other peoples property)
- Also people parking to go shopping
- The ambulance and resident (tail gate wheelchair access vehicles) cannot get in/out of Close. Access is required twice a day by the Day Care Staff and resident regularly.

We propose that if we had a double yellow line on the corner this would solve the access problem.

Council Response

Thank you for your petition regarding inconsiderate parking on Peel Court.

After undertaking a site visit, I am happy to place this location on our waiting restrictions request list, with the view to have double yellow lines implemented. The effect of this will mean that vehicles will be prohibited from parking on both the footway and carriageway at this location, improving access for vehicles, visibility and overall road safety. The review of this waiting list is undertaken on an annual basis, and we anticipate the next review being completed later on this year, followed by a formal consultation on our proposals giving the residents the opportunity to make representations. The usual timescale for a scheme to be implemented is between 9-12 months.
