NEW SURGERY IN COLNBROOK

To the Partners of Langley Health Centre, NHS England, Slough Clinical Commissioning Group, and Slough Borough Council.

We the people of the Parish of Colnbrook with Poyle require the continuation of a Branch Doctors Surgery In the heart of this community. There has always been a surgery in this village since the birth and development of the NHS. The Parish has a population approaching 7,000 people. Additional homes are currently being built.

The impending closure of the current premises gives an opportunity to establish a better facility. A new surgery offering at least 10 regular sessions a week, every week would be well used if properly offered to Colnbrook residents. The inconsistency of opening hours at the Wheelwrights Place premises and difficulties in obtaining appointments when required gave a false impression of the demand to have a local branch.

There are no direct public transport links to The Health Centre In Common Road, Langley. This Increases the need for car journeys when traffic levels and associated pollution continues to be a problem effecting health.

We are advised that uptake of immunisation programmes and screening is very low in our Parish and therefore better access to healthcare is a necessity. Please respond positively to this petition with a **NEW SURGERY IN COLNBROOK**.
