Council Response

Thank you for the submission of the above petition on 20th March 2017. There were also some additional signatures submitted on 3rd April 2017 and 12th April 2017, however in accordance with the Council petition scheme, we cannot accept these after the petition has closed.

The Council also received a petition opposing the introduction of residents permit parking on King Edward Street. In order to get the most accurate picture of resident opinion, we compared individual addresses rather than the number of signatures, as both petitions contain multiple signatures from each property. The results are inconclusive; therefore we will be undertaking some further investigation and consulting with the Ward Councillors to make a decision on how best to proceed.
