

# Paper Petition Details

## Chalvey Road East – Request for Permit Holders Parking

It would be extremely unfair and prejudice treatment of the Council to authorise Permits for those residents of College Avenue, Ragstone Road and Martin Road without acknowledging the rights of residents of Chalvey Road East. Majority of our homes have lost parking since the one way system and residents of other streets park in the bays outside our homes.
