Sheehy Way Car Park

We, the undersigned strongly object to the Council's proposal to build houses on the Car Park in Sheehy Way.

Our reasons include:

- Loss of car park facility
- Loss of the open character of the area
- Noise & Disturbance
- Loss of privacy for residents
- Loss of light for residents
- Overshadowing blocked views
- Resultant traffic congestion in the area
- Loss of existing trees
- Layout & density of the buildings
- Reduction in property values
- Anti social behaviour

There is a demand for parking In the area as the public car park facility provides vital use for the community in the locality: The loss of this facility will have a major impact on traffic in the surrounding area leading to people parking on the side roads and grass verges on The Frithe.

Not only will the development restrict outside space, impact on drainage/sewer services, it will increase noise and traffic pollution as visitors will seek alternative parking thereby ruining the grass verges, and engaging in anti social behaviour and disputes with residents wanting access to their properties.
