### Decisions to be made by the Cabinet as a matter of urgency Date of Notice: 13<sup>th</sup> March 2019

Reason for urgency	The Cabinet agreed to the disposal in December 2018. Authorisation is being sort to extend the completion deadline from the 16th March 2019 to 10th May 2019. Extension to deadline requires urgent consideration so that sale process can continue without interruption and remove the risk of parties incurring abortive costs.
