

Notice of Forthcoming Key Decisions and Decisions to be Taken in Private

Decisions to be made by the Cabinet as a matter of urgency Date of Notice: 30th June 2020

Local authorities are required to publish a Notice of key decisions and/or of their intention to hold a meeting of the Executive ('the Cabinet') in private at least 28 clear days before the meeting. This Notice sets out decisions to be taken at an extraordinary meeting of the Cabinet on 30th June 2020 which have not been included on previously published statutory notices (the Notification of Key Decisions). In accordance with the Regulations, the Chair of the Overview & Scrutiny Committee, has been informed of the matters to be considered at the meeting and where required has agreed that the key decision(s) can be taken in private.

Reason for urgency	The Council is required to produce a local outbreak management plan for Slough to help reduce the spread of coronavirus locally and to seek to contain any outbreaks. The Cabinet will be asked to endorse the plan for Slough and it is impracticable to defer the decision as doing so would delay implementation of the plan and cause risk to public health.
