## **Council Response**

You very kindly organised a recent petition requesting a parking enforcement scheme to be introduced on Denbigh Close.

As the land in question is owned by the Housing Department it is, as far as parking enforcement is concerned, considered as private land so we need specific agreements in place to set up any scheme.

I have discussed this with my colleagues in Parking and am pleased to say that this scheme will be considered for formal consultation and design. However, my colleagues have advised me that due to the long list of other projects already being considered there could be a significant delay in starting this project.

This is the case for a number of other roads on Housing land and we are currently investigating if it is possible to introduce a short term, interim solution using a private parking contractor. There are some draw-backs to having a private enforcement scheme in place so we need to make sure we don't fix one problem only to create another. Once we have more information about whether this is possible we will update you further.
