Date of Notice: 8th July 2022

Reason for urgency	The decision is part of the ongoing improvement work within the Council we have been reviewing all the activity underway to support the remediation and modernisation of our technology infrastructure. It has become increasingly apparent that without a rapid change to the skills and capability of the ICT & Digital Team that Slough will be exposed to unacceptable risk for too long, and they will struggle to effectively support the new Corporate Plan.
