

## Notice of Forthcoming Key Decisions Published in Accordance with the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements)

(Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012

## Decisions to be made by the Cabinet as a matter of urgency Date of Notice: 25th October 2022

Local authorities are required to publish a Notice of key decisions and/or of their intention to hold a meeting of the Executive ('the Cabinet') in private at least 28 clear days before the meeting. This Notice sets out decisions to be taken at the meeting of the Cabinet on 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2022 which have not been included on previously published statutory notices (the Forward Plan).

In accordance with the Regulations, the Chair of the Overview & Scrutiny has been informed of the matters to be considered and has agreed the Cabinet can meet in private and that call-in can be waived on the grounds of urgency.
