1. Summary

- 1.5 The new Joint Health and Wellbeing Strategy will be a 10-year report of the Slough Health and Wellbeing Board. The local Place Plan is an annual delivery plan of the Health and Care Partnership Board (also known as Slough's Place Board) and is an officer-led Board.
